



BECOME AN AVIATION SHEET METAL WORKER LEARN BY BECOMING A PAID APPRENTICE



AAR is launching a sheet metal worker initiative that will feed into their United States Department of Labor registered apprentice program. The sheet metal program is the entry point for the AAR aviation technician position. The program is 16 weeks with candidates earning \$15-\$16 dollars an hour. If the candidates successfully complete the sheet metal worker program, they are moved into the two year AAR apprenticeship program. Additionally, when the apprentice completes the apprenticeship program, they are able to test to earn their air frame and/or power certification. At that time the employee can make an average hourly rate of \$30.00.



Eligibility

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must have a HS Diploma or GED
- Must be able to pass a level 2 background check
- Must be a resident of Miami-Dade County
- Must be eligible to work in the U.S.

Benefits

- 16 weeks of work based learning
- \$16.00/hour; 40 hours a week
- Opportunity for entry into the AAR apprenticeship program
